

The “rapid start” for unmatched RBCs in the Cerner Bridge is now functional.

Please see short PPT for a reminder of how to use. Covered in the Bridge modules as well.

I will instruct the blood bank to stop sending uncrossmatched downtime forms at 8 AM tomorrow morning so you can send this messaging to KHSC.

I have cc. ED, ICU, perfusion, and OR where 99% of uncrossed units are used (as an advanced notice).

Please ensure messaging goes to nursing as well as physicians.

The key failure point is it asks for the second user’s username and password for the co-signature BUT you need to scan your linear barcode on your badge. Cerner does not tell you to do this. It is a secret. Usernames and passwords do NOT work. Only your badge barcode number. We can’t change this.
